## The Acts 1:8 One Day Mission Trip “A Mississippi River Ministry Project”

It was a great day for Arkansas Baptist as over 85 churches and over 1,000 Arkansas Southern Baptist were on mission in the Pine Bluff area, Saturday, Sept. 11. These missionaries did ministry in over 68 sites across Pine Bluff and the Harmony Association. Reports from the association are over 50 salvations experiences. It was an awesome day to see over 1,000 believers gather together and be sent out to share Jesus across one of our Arkansas communities.

This one day mission trip will now become an annual event for Arkansas Baptist. When you see God at work we want to join him there. We are seeing God lead us in many directions after this one day mission experience. Many churches and associations are going back and planning their one day mission trip in their communities. Other churches and associations are asking how to become more involved in missions after this one day mission experience. We are in the planning stages now for next year and will announce a date very soon.

Here is some praise information from the day:

- Over 50 professions of faith report as of today
- Over 85 churches participated
- Over 1,000 Arkansas Southern Baptist were on mission in Pine Bluff, Saturday, Sept. 11
- Over 68 Sites in the Harmony Association
- The Forrest City Disaster Relief Feeding Unit and Block Parties fed over 2,000 people
- Over 250 of the 1,000 missionaries were under the age of 18

Team Information:

- Over 180 Prayer Walkers in 27 Teams, three salvations reported.
- There were 4 Children's Sites with over 500 in total attendance and they reported of eleven being saved.
- There were four Youth Sites with over 200 in total attendance
- There were four Sr. Adult Teams that visited five Nursing Homes and ministered to over 50 people, with 2 being saved.
- There were 12 home repair projects completed in Home Repairs with over 135 missionaries doing ministry in this area.
- The Medical and Dental Clinic gave medical help to 99 people and 10 were saved.
- The Evangelistic Team did three surveys in the community, Ministered at area Car Washes and Laundromats by sharing quarters and sharing Jesus at the same time. They reported three being led to Christ.
- The Yard Work Team mowed and cleaned up 49 yards, led three to Christ, and 32 new contacts to follow up on.
- There were two Block Parties with over 600 in attendance, Shared the Gospel over 200 times and reported one saved. One church reported after one of the area block parties that they had first time guest the following day in worship and some back for Sunday evening worship.
- There was one tailgate party at Bulldog Stadium in White Hall. The missionaries gave out water to all the fans and one of the local church's band played.
